



Fabric Needs

- 1 - 10" x 5" piece of regular cotton fabric
- 1 - 10" x 5" piece of minky or fleece fabric
- 1 - 15" piece of 1/2" or 5/8" elastic
- matching thread

Instructions

- 1) Print and cut out the pattern from the paper.
- 2) Cut out fabric pieces using the pattern above.
- 3) Cut your elastic to your preferred size. I cut a 15" piece for mine because I like my mask a little bit loose.
You can always cut yours smaller depending on your preferences and size of head.
- 4) On the right side of your cotton piece, line up the elastic ends to the notches on the pattern and pin.
- 5) Place the minky and cotton fabrics right sides together with the elastic on the inside and pin.
- 6) Sew the two pieces of fabric together using a 1/4" seam allowance leaving about a 2 1/2" opening at the top.
I like to sew over the elastic a few times to make sure it doesn't come out when stretched.
- 7) Pull the material right sides out through the opening at the top and press down the top opening with an iron.
- 8) Edge stitch all around the mask just short of 1/4" to close the opening at the top.

Please note:

When printing, set Page Scaling to "None" or else the pattern may be too small and won't print to the correct size.
